of North Carolina County of Carter being of sound & perfect mind
memory & able to do this day 23rd March in the year of our Lord
1834 to make and publish this my last will & testament in manner & form
that I give and bequeath to my son Daniel Mashburn one hundred
dollars in money to him his heirs & assigns forever -

I then I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Mashburn the land
plantation wherein I now live containing two hundred & thirty four
acres in the part of the south west of said river and my upper
half of the same on the east of an uninclosed acre adjoining
the above at the south west beginning at a stake in the
quarries across the river with William Carter corner public & also
give him one negro man named Peter one yearling named
John one cow & calves five head of sheep one goat and
four hogs one duck one small trout one goose the same
which still are now put shooting the said fish one steel
trap and all my Cartridges tools one set of books money
one crop set & also one slate to him his heirs & assigns forever -

I then I give & bequeath to my daughter Martha Duff one negro boy
named David in his possession one large new pot & one
large painted chest to her her heirs & assigns forever -

I then I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Ward one
negro boy named Thompson chest to her her heirs & assigns forever -

I then I give & bequeath to my daughter Betty Scott one negro woman
named Kate one small painted chest to her her heirs & assigns forever -

I then I give & bequeath to my daughter Susannah Engwines one negro
boy named John chest to her her heirs & assigns forever -

I then I give and bequeath to my grand son John Kinney fifty dollars
in money to him his heirs and assigns forever -

I then I have my negro man named Isaac to be sold the money
arising therefrom I give to my daughter Ann Carter to her
and her heirs and assigns forever -

I then I give and bequeath to my grand son Joseph Barker fifty dollars
to him and his heirs and assigns forever -

I then I give and bequeath to my grand son Thomas Barker fifty
dollars to him and his heirs and assigns forever -

I then I give and bequeath to my grand son Jackson Barker fifty
dollars to him and his heirs and assigns forever -

I then I give and bequeath to my son in law Thomas Barker one dollar
to him and his heirs and assigns forever -

I then I have my negro man that to be sold for the purpose of
paying off my said above mentioned grand sons legacies
namely John Kinney, Joseph Barker, Thomas Barker and Jackson Barker

I then I give and bequeath to my four daughters names as follows
Elizabeth Ward Betty Scott, Susannah Engwines and Martha Duff
all my lands not herein disposed of to be equally
divided according to the value between my four above mentioned
daughters Elizabeth, Betty, Susannah & Martha to them
their heirs and assigns forever -

My will and desire that all personal Estate of what kind
should be sold and the money arising therefrom to be equally
divided between my seven children namely Daniel and
Thomas Mashburn Ann Carter, Elizabeth Ward Betty Scott
Susannah Engwines Martha Duff to them their heirs & assigns

Publicly make and ordain my son Thomas Mathison
and my dear friend James Oliver Executors to his
my last will and testament in charge of the said
Thomas Mathison and to this my last will and tes-
tament set my hand and affixed my seal the day &
date first above written signed sealed acknowledged
& proved of
