I Urick Canady of the County of Onslow and State
of North Carolina. I Urick Canady do considering
myself in light mind and having my perfect sense
and memory blessed by god for the same I do make
this my last will and Testament on the thirteenth
day of December in the year of Our Lord one thousand
Eight Hundred and thirty six —

1st I recommend my soul in the hands of Almighty
God who gave it — I do that my request is that
all my just debts be ^{settled} paid and all my funeral
Expenses to be paid out of my Estate —

2d I give and bequeath unto my oldest son James
Canady a certain piece of or parcel of Land whereon
he now lives included as follows Beginning at the
Mouth of a Branch near the Landing on Beagles
Creek running up said Branch to the Back line
then with the back line to said Beagles Creek
or Branch thence down branch and Creek to
the first Station —

4th I also give and bequeath unto my other two oldest
sons David Canady and Richard Canady a certain
piece of Land bounded as follows beginning at
the mouth of said Branch with my oldest sons
beginning on Beagles Creek thence the various
courses of said Creek down to the Mouth thence
up Indians Creek to the old Bridge thence thence
out with a crop fence as it now stands to the
first pair of Bars thence from said Bars a straight course
to the outward corner of my Garden from my house
thence from the Corner of my Garden a direct

to my back line then with ¹⁰back line to the division
line between James Canada and my other two oldest
sons with the first named Branch beginning at the
Landing ~~unto my youngest son Elijah Canada to~~
Beagle Creek 5th I also give and Bequeath unto my
youngest son Elijah Canada to hold with David &
Richard Canada's line a piece of Land beginning
at the old Bridge on Sulwicks Creek then up said
Creek to the mouth of the first Branch thence up said
Branch to Hannashs Branch thence up Hannashs branch
to the Back line thence bounded with the back line and
last Division line to the old Bridge - - -

6th I also give and bequeath unto my son Yachariah
Canada a certain piece of land lying and bounded
as follows lying and back of Hannashs branch beginning
at the head of said Branch running with my back line
the various courses of said line come in and down to the
above named boundary Elijah Canada line

7th I also give and Bequeath unto my loving wife My
Canada during her natural life all of my Parishable
Property consisting of Stock house hold and Kitchen garden
Farming Utensils &c. to hold during life or the same hereafter
then to be sold and Equally divided between all of my
Daughters & viz; Leticia, Rebecca, Elijah, Ann, Elizabeth, Nathaniel
Mary I also give and Bequeath unto my daughter
Rebecca Canada one Cow & Calf to be obtained this
incoming Spring - 8th My Will also is that my two
sons James and David Canada pay unto my wife
Mary Canada thirty Dollars each Considering it to
be the Value of a house each which they have had
from me more than my other living

9th My Will and desire also is that one of my daughters
live without a lawful heir for her share to return me to
all of my Daughters then living and I hereby ~~mean~~ ^{mean} and
