a low state of health but of sound mind and

Earth at the discretion of my executors, and disposing
my worldly estate, I dispose of it in the following
manner - viz -

First It is my will and desire that my brother Leff
and John Smith have my land that I bought of

of money I am now owing of them (the copy
thereof excepted) to them the said Leff & John shall
their heirs & assigns forever -

I also give unto my sister Polly Barber her heirs
lawfully begotten of her body the land that I bought
of James Whitman to be by her and them, & assigns during
her and their lives as to be by her in the lifetime of her
heirs, & assigns a by her sold under the same restrictions
in former Leff prop. title to land, & inherit by the
death of parents - I also give my brother William
Smith the land I bought of John Barber (the copy of them
excepted) to him the said William his heirs and
assigns forever, my land on which William Smith now
lives I wish to be sold by my Executors at public
sale at six months Credit, the price of which will
be hereafter disposed of hereafter -
I also leave my land that I bought of Benjamin
