I constitute make and ordain my loving Sons, Aaron Barefield, Nathon Barefield Exetrs. of this My Lest Will and Testement and I hereby utterly disallow nevoke disanul, all and every other former Testement Wills Legaus begueathes & exetrs by me in anywise before named Willed Bequeathed, ratyfing and confirming this and no other to be my Last Will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this Fifth day of April One Thousend Eight Hundred and One

Item: I Give to My Daughter Sarah Five Negroes that is Say Easter "aniel Harvy and Sampson and Harriot Two Beds to Her & her Heirs for Ever.

Item: I give to My Daughter Penelapa Three Negroes Sue Ussey and David to her and her Heirs for ever.

Item: I Give to Son Benjamin the Land and Plantation that I Bought of John Orrel and One third part of My Mill to Him and his Heirs for ever.

Item: I Give to Son John one Half the Land and Plantation I now Live On to be laid of next to My Mill abso one third Part of My Mill to him and his Heirs for ever.

Item: I Give to My son Thomas the other half of the Plantstion I now live on only Reserving My Beloved Wifes Life in Said Land also one third part of My Mill to him and his Heirs for ever.

Item: I Give to My sons Bemjamin John and Thomas two Negro Men Namely Sharp and Sam to be to the Supporting of the Mill at the Dascresion of My Executors hear after Mentioned to him and his Heirs For ever.

Item: I Lend to My Beloved Wife Lewcretis One Negre Man Named James and after her Death to be Equally Devided Bowen all My Heirs It is also My Will that all the Rest and Residue of my Estate Not Given away Should be the use of Paying Just Debts It is further My Will that it Should be in Power of My Executors to Keep up the Mill or to Rent it out Yearly.

Item: I settle the following negros upon my Friends & their session as Trustees of My Daughter Mary Fields (John Harber my son and Hinton Barber giving unto them full power and at all times to prevent any waste or damage negroes names Jake after the deease of my wife, Irma Rachel Kate Sal and their increase Jake after the deease of my wife, Irma Rachel Kate Sal and their increase of the Ilfe and after mere deease the same & increase to be equally and fairly of her life and after mere deease the same & increase to be equally and fairly devided among her Children to share and share alike , them and their assigns

Item: I give and bequeath unto My Grandson Thomas Harber and John Barber Children of My oldest son the Late Joseph Harber the Plantation I purchesed of the heirs of the Late Thomas Gibson Whereas their Father Dies containing 600 acres more or less to share and share alike them their heirs and assigns forever.
