in the whole or either of them or an acc^t.
of Disobeying the requests as before inserted
Put down and written after the whole of this
my last will and Testament as duly Acknowledged
faithfully Committed and fulfilled my
son Peter shall have all my Negroes or
the Residue of Stock lands and Every
thing Else now or may become him after
in full Clear and Absolute Possession to
Dispose of as his dear Right and title
Unto some unknown persons that perhaps
may now be or be here after if such be
~~now~~ now or be here after it shall be
Equally Divided betwixt my wife and children
as witness my hand and seal this fourth Day of
August 1771

February the 20th in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand
Seven Hundred & Twenty one make and Publisheth my
last will and Testament in Manner and form following
that is to say first I bind to my wife Ann Baskett
all my Goods Chattels that I am possessed with
Except one bed and furniture which Give to my
son William Baskett I also bind to my wife Ann
Baskett the tract of land that I now live on with all
the Appurtenances Belonging there to her use Except
my debts to be paid out of the moveable Estate
which I owe in this County Note this Possession that
I have Endured my wife Ann Baskett with is only to
stand till my son Thomas Baskett comes of age or
marries then for him to be the sole Owner and Possess
her of that tract of land that I now live on and
otherwise half my moveable Estate and the other half
I give and Bequeath to my wife Ann Baskett
also giving to my wife what money is owing to
me in Butte County after my debts is paid thine
also give and Bequeath to my son William Baskett
my Negro boy named Job also also a tract of
land lying in Butte County Extenting one hundred
acres But if my son William Baskett should die
without heirs I give and his Right to my son
Thomas Baskett but if my son Thomas Baskett
should die without heirs I give and bequeath

his tract to my wife Ann Bastatt also 2 gun
and Bequath to my Brother James Bastatt
my son william Bastatt for his use and living
until he comes of age I also send to my Brother
James Bastatt my Negro Boy named Bob until
my son william comes of age and no longer
and John by make and appoint my loving
friends Thomas fate and James Bastatt my just
and sole Executors of this my last will and
testament hereby Revoking disannulling and
making void all other wills Declaring this only to
be my last will & testament in witness where
of I have here unto set my hand and affix
my seal the day and date above written

well beloved son James Mordagh that Plantation
