North Carolina being very sick and weak of Body but of

Therefore calling to mind the mortality of my Body and —
Knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die
do make and Ordain this my last will and Testament —
that is to say Principally and first I recommend my soul into
the hands of God that gave it and my Body I commend
to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian like and decent
Manner at the Discretion of my Executors nothing doubting
but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again
by the mighty Power of God and as touching such —
Worldly Estate wherewithal it hath pleased God to bless me
earth in this life I give Demise and Bequeath of the
same in the following manner and form first all that

all my just & lawful Debts and Funeral charges be paid —
I Intermittent Give and Bequeath unto my Deare and
well beloved wife Ruth Bechell all my lands goods and Chattels
during her widowhood to raise my Children on and after her
Marriage for my Personal Estate to be sold and the money equally
Divided amongst my three Daughters Mary Elizabeth and Ruth
as they Marry or arrive to the age of twenty one Years —
and my Lands I give and Bequeath to my sons Thomas and
William to be Divided between them as follows for Thomas that
part of my land that lyeth on the north side of my spring branch
with the plantation and for William that part that on the south
side of the spring branch the Dividing line between them is such
to run a south line from the Spring to my south corner on the
bank and along my spring branch to the River and I likewise
Commit and Appoint my trusty & Beloved Friends William
White and John Bechell Executors of this my last will and
Testament Revoking and Abolishing all other Wills Testa-
ments Bequeathments by me anyways heretofore made —
Rectifying and Confirming this and no other to be my last
Will and Testament in witness whereof I have set my hand
and Seal the Day and Year above mentioned
