The condition of the above bill of sale is such that if the above Asa Blake do and shall pay of and discharge the said bond of Two hundred and thirtyfive pounds three shillings and sixpence and receive a receipt in full for the same from I. Phillips and Wray and discharge the said James Blake from his security ship then this obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue

Rhoads for myself my executors and administrators all and singular the said Negroe girl Juno unto the said Joseph Moore his executors administrators and assigns against me the said William Rhoads my executors and administrators and assigns and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and for ever defend by these presents In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the Twentyfirst day July anno domini one thousand seven hundred and Eighty six and Eleventh year of American Independence
