

I know all men by these presents that I Asa Blake of the County of Wake and State of North Carolina for and in Consideration of James Blake standing security for I Asa Blake to the administrators of Bay and James Blake in a bond of Two hundred and thirtyfive pounds three and sixpence payable twelve months after date and to make him the said James Blake of the County of Orange and State of North Carolina secure safe clear and free from all damages that may arise or insue on the said Asa Blake not paying of and discharging the said bond is the said Asa Blake do make over deliver and grant and by these presents hath made over and cleaved and granted unto the said James Blake his heirs or assigns to and for his or their proper use and behoof one negro wench called Lanny and one negro fellow called Ned as his or their property and do for me and my heirs warrant and defend the said Negroes from all person or persons who shall lay any Clame title or litle to the said Negroes to the I James Blake his heirs and assigns for ever in Witnes whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 25th day of Novem^r 1785.

The Condition of the above bill of sale is such that if the above Asa Blake do and shall pay of and discharge the I bond of Two hundred and thirtyfive pounds three shillings and sixpence and receive a receipt in full for the same from I Philips and Massey and discharge the I James Blake from his securityship then this obligation to be void other wise to remain in full force and Virtue signed Seal^d and delivered in presence of
