 after Marriage or Decease, to be sold and Delivered amongst my wife
 and my Remaining Children and the Remainder of my Estate
 to be sold, my wife to have one third part of it, the Rest to be Divided
 amongst my Children and I appoint my beloved Friends Lewis Kirk
 and Richard Cate my soul Executors and Managers of my Estate

claim of all & every Person and Persons whomsoever

and J. B. Benton or either of them severally my sole and
full power and authority to make sign seal and deliver
for me and in my Name any (Deed or Deeds) Conveyance
or Conveyances to pass any Receipt or Receipts or to any
other thing or things that they or either of them shall
think necessary for the more effectually disposing of all
and singular my Estate both real & Personal and settling
adjusting & finally closing my Accounts in as ample
and full a manner as I myself could do was I
