of God through Jesus Christ his Son whose Death & blood
secured my Soul to be saved. I now as touching my
worldly Estate, that it hath pleased God to give me
I give & dispose of in manner & form following.

First, To my dear & beloved wife Sarah
Colman, the one third of all I possess. I have had & purchased
where I sold the said Estate & I desire to be buried
the third of my Estate, the rest I dispose of in the manner
& form following. First, I devise all after my wife
dies, Equally amongst my four children, to wit Mary
Elizabeth, Samuel & William. them to have equal shares
after my burial & other Expenses in paid by my
Executors hereafter named. & I do constitute &c.

Second my dear & beloved wife Sarah, & James
Threlkeld my whole whole Estate of the my last
will & Testament, Residing, & following all
debts hereafter made & debts by
me. Allowing this only to be my last will &c.

all my children being living &c. in the County of the
