I Charles Foshier of the County of Orange, being very
Sick & Weak and being but of perfect & sound mind &
Memory thanks be to God, therefore (calling) to mind the
Mortality of my body & that it is appointed for all men once
to die, do make & ordain this my last will & Testa-
ment, that is to Say principally I fear of all, I commend
my Soul unto the hands of Almighty who gave it &
my body I commit to the earth, to be buried in a Christian
like & Decent manner at the discretion of my Executors
Nothing doubting, but the General Resurrection I shall
know the same again, by the mighty power of God
I as touching such worldly Estate wherewith I hold
pleased Almighty God to bless me with in this life I
give & devise thereof in the following manner, I give.

Imprimis, I leave unto Susanna my dearly beloved
Wife, every thing I have during her widowhood, if ever
she marries I cut her off to her thirds & these the same
to be Equally Divided between my two Sons, William
Foshier & Charles Foshier, every thing else that I
have, to be sold for money & Equally Divided -
amongst my Children -

Item I give to my Loving Wife all my Personal Estate
of Cattle Hogs & horses, to her and her heirs forever

Item I do Constitute & appoint my Loving Wife
Priscilla Executor of this my last Will & Testament
