mortality of my body & that it is appointed for all men and  
to die, do make & ordain this my last will & testa-  
ment that is to say principally & first of all I command  
my soul into the hands of Almighty who gave it &  
my body I commit to the earth to be buried in a Christian  
like & decent manner at the discretion of my executors  
nothing doubting but the general resurrection I leave  
know the same again by the mighty power of God  
as touching such earthly Estates wherewithal it hath

I have alwayes had God to help me with in the life &  
now I do in th' following manner & form.  
Inasmuch as I have unto Suanne my deare blood  
wif, every thing I have during her wedchhead, if now  
she marries & cut her off to her third & then the same  
to be Equally Dividized between my two Sons William  
Fosher & Charles Fosher, every thing else that I  
have to be sold for money & Equally Dividized  
amongst my Children.

on I stnd gives the rest of the said Land & plantation  
to my loving Wif Priscilla, to her & her heirs forever  
I stnd I give to my loving Wif all my personal Estate  
of cattle Hogs & horses, to her own Disposall

I do constellute & appoint my loving Wif  
Priscilla Executrix of the my last Will & Testament  
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal my  
test the 18th Day of October 1760
