Item, I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Farley my Negro Man George & Pate and the other half of Pate's increase also the rest of my personal Estate to be equally divided between my son and daughter, Item I do appoint my Wife Sarah, John James Farley & William Price Executors of this my last Will and Testament, whereunto I have set my hand & signed myself in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & seventy six & Twentieth day of March
