 my Beloved wife Mary Hardin to Raising my Children on directing
 her wisdom Good but if she should marry for the whole of my
 Estate to be Equally divided amongst them that is amongst
 my wife and three children which is now in being and also
 apart to one which is on loan at this present and I do appoint
 my wife Mary Hardin & Thomas late Sole Executors of this
 my last will & Testament in witness where of I do hereunto
 set my hand & affix my Seal the day & year above written

North Carolina This day came Victory Planting before me & made oath
 Orange County that she was at Hosa Tappan's Jun. some few days
 before he died in his sickness and being in his proper senses said
 that it was his desire that the Part of Land & Plantation the South
 Side of Flat River where on the thing lived was for his Son John
 Pryor Tappan and the other part on the North Side of said River
 was for his other Son Hosa Tappan which this Eruption that if
 his wife was with Child and should be again when Born that his
 Desire that Land might be divided in Three Equal Parts for them &
 that he died on the 21st of March in the year 1770 sworn before
 me this 22nd day of March 1770

 George all my Wearing apparel I am I give unto my well
 beloved George Twenty Shillings and no more I am I give unto all the
 rest of my Estate in the Care of my well beloved wife
 Ellenor George during her widowhood as follows house
 hold Goods & Moveables Hogs cattle Negroes with all the
 working tools for the Plantation use and after
 the decease of or Decese of my well beloved wife

Elliner George that then the Negroes House hold Goods
Horses and Crops fettle and whatsoever of my Estate
then Remaining to be sold and Equally divided
Amongst my Children then living and if my son
Ambrose George should decease with out your lawful
Beyetter of his body that then his Part Equally to
be divided a mongst the Rest of my Children then
living as follows William George James George Isac
George Mary Winsford fathum Riddle and Pyrry
George - also Give in ~~any~~ the hands of my
two Male Co. 411 Acres of Land which Power
to sell I make a Right to the same if Not sold
before my decease and after discharging all my
lawfull debts the Remaining Part of the Money
to be Equally divided a mongst the Rest of
my Children then living Excepting my son Isaac
George and this concludes my last will and Testament
Ranking and anying all other wills here to fore
by me made as witness I have hereunto set my
hand and Sealed my Seal this Countenth day of
February One thousand seven Hundred thirty Apyear
in Presence of - Appointing my wife Colored her
Ambrose George and my son James George with
my wife Colored wife Elliner George my sole and
sole Co. of this my last will and testament aforesaid
in Presence of -
