Know all Men by these presents that I James Frazer of Orange County & State of North Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred Guineas att Seventy one Shillings Sterling Money each to me in Hand paid by Thomas Hart of the County & State aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have bargained sold & Delivered & by these Presents doth bargain sell & deliver unto the said Thomas Hart Twelve Negro Slaves to wit, John, Jim, Fanny, Charlotte, Tabby Aggy, Edie Jib, Eber, & George now in my possession and Estate & Colorado, run away, which said twelve Negro Slaves & every of them I do hereby warrant & defend unto the said Thomas Hart his Heirs & Assigns forever against the claim of all & every Person and Persons whomsoever.

Know all Men by these Presents that I Thomas Hart of the County of Orange and State of North Carolina for divers good cause and considerations me therunto moving have made ordained constituted and appointed and by these Presents do make ordain constitute and appoint my trusty Friends James Hogg and J. B. Banton of the County & State aforesaid my true & lawful Attorneys for me in my Name and to my use, to bargain sell or otherwise dispose of any part or parcel of my Estate either real or Personal to Collect the Debts that may be due to me and pay those that may be ~~owing~~ due from me, hereby giving & by these presents granting to my said Attorneys James Hogg and J. B. Banton or either of them severally my sole and full power and Authority to make sign Seal and deliver for me and in my Name any Deed or Deeds Conveyance, or Conveyances to pass any Receipt or Receipts or to any other thing or things that they or either of them shall think necessary for the more effectually disposing of all and singular my Estate both real & Personal and settling adjusting & finally closing my Accounts in as ample and full a manner as I myself could do was I Personally Present hereby ratifying and confirming whatever

my said Attornies or either of them shall do in and about

In the name of God Amen. I Thomas Capper of
the County of Orange State of North Carolina being
weak in Body but of perfect sense and Memory
(blessed be God for the same) do this 19th Day of
October in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven
hundred and Seventy seven I do hereby make and
publish this my last Will and Testament in manner
and form following. Viz. first I recommend my Soul
to Almighty God and my Body to the Earth to
be buried at the discretion of my Executors and Executors
hereafter named. Secondly I bequeath to my Dear
beloved Wife Anna Capper all my right Title claims
of all my Lands and moveables whatsoever with all
my Stocks of Cattle of all kind, excepting two
Cows and Calf already given to my Daughter Nancy

Capper. I also lend to dear Beloved Wife Anna Capper
Three Negroes Slaves named Marica Mary and Sam with all
and every thing before mentioned during her Widowhood and no
longer. I give and bequeath to my dear and only Daughter
Nancy Capper the Negroes one named Sall the other named Mena
to her and Heirs forever. I also give and Bequeath to my
dear and only Daughter Nancy Capper, after my just and lawful
Debts are paid, and my Dear Wife Widowhood, all my right
and property and proberty of all Lands Houses, Buildings Negro
Slaves, Goods and Chattels real and Personal wholly and solely and
for and Heirs forever. Lastly I nominate constitute and
appoint my Faithful and trusty Friends and Wife, Tapley
Cutter, John Capper and James Isaac Junior Executors &
Executrix of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking
and disannulling all other Will or Wills by me made
in word or Writing. In Witness whereof I the said Thomas
Capper have to this my last Will and Testament set
my Hand and affixed my Seal the Day and Year above
