Cow & Calf, as also the whole Estate to be and remain in her  
Hands till the Day of her Death or Marriage at her discretion  
Item, I give and bequeath to my living daughter Elizabeth Horner five  
Shillings Sterling to be lived and paid out of my Estate  
together with that part she has already received to her and her  
Heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my dear son Samuel the sum of five  
Shillings Sterling to be lived and paid out of my Estate  
together with that part he hath already received to him and his  
Heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Bridget five Shillings  
Sterling to be lived and paid out of my Estate to her and  
her Heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my living Daughter Mary Peader  
five Shillings Sterling, together with that part she hath  
already received to her and her Heirs & Pages forever.

Item I give and bequeath to remainder of the Children of the  
body of Martha my third wife, the remainder part of  
my personal Estate, Her family, Pupillas Savannah,  
Ann, Stephen Raebell, Ruth Jane Alice.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving Son Stephen, the planter  
whereof I now own, containing two hundred & forty acres  
more or less after the death of my wife, to him and his  
Heirs & Pages forever.

Item I also constitute and appoint my dearly beloved wife Martha
