 & Deborah & Elizabeth Lindsey, when he have five
 Pounds of Price, & it is my Will that William
 Lindsey son of James Lindsey, when he have five
 Pounds, and of said Slaves not sold within three
 after my Discharge, their being enough to discharge
 my Just Ditts without them. My Brother or Brother
 in Law come not in by said time, it is my Will
 that William Lindsey when he have such the above
 mentioned Slave, when he come to the age of Eighteen
 Years & it is my Will that Samuel Stewart when he
 have my Slave Hannah, when she come to the age
 of Eighteen Years & it is my Will, that Thomas
 Lindsey, James when he have my Slave Sarah &
 Deborah. & my last Child & Warrington have &
 it is my Will that if my Brother or Brother in Law

 & Samuel Stewart, I will, I appoint my friends
 Samuel Stewart, & William Lindsey Executors of this
 my last will & Testament in trust for the intents
 & purposes herein mentioned in Witness whereof
 & the said Hugh Lewis have hereunto set my hand
 & Seal the Day & Year first above Written, to this my last
 Will & Testament.
