& Testament in manner & form following (that is to say)  
First I give my Daughter Rachal twenty five pounds Credt  
at Virginias Money Wher Ever & to my Daughter Mary  
gives twenty five pounds Virginias Money a Brone & Mans  
Cott. & a Cow & Calf & two Sheep but if either of them goes out  
in Marriage Contrary to the rule & custom among friends then  
they shall have but ten pounds each of them. I assign to  
my Daughter of her former proclamation Money. & to my  
Daughter Rachal if she comes howe soevre & thirteene  
Pounds to my Daughter Mary I do leave a Plantation of  
Land lying at John Williamson Creek. And to my  
Daughter Betty & to her the Plantation of Land I  
now live on, and to my Daughter Rachal & Mary it is  
in my Will that they shall have their Spinning Whiles  
I do give & bequeath unto my Daughter Rachal  
of my Goods, Cattell & Movables, for her own proper uses that  
is now on the Premises. I do also make & Ordaine my  
Daughter Rachael Charlotte & John Marshall my sole Executrix  
of this my Will in trust for the intent purpose in  
the my Will contained. In witness whereof I the said  
Henry Maynes to this my last Will & Testament set my  
hand & seal the day & year first above written  
Signed sealed & delivered by the said Henry Maynes  
Last Will & Testament in the presence  
of us who were present at the signing  
& sealing thereof

Memory do make this my Last Will & Testament

Liberation I give & bequeath as follows

& that the said Warham Glan make my son James Atkinson  
adies for the other half of running up the River to  
William Hobkirk his for Compliment & to William Glan  
for so doing. I give & bequeath the Plantations wherein  
I now live, two hundred acres of Land to the said  
now on life to him his heirs & assigns forever. Also do  
give to Warham Glan forty Pounds Virginias Money  
to be paid next overles my Burial. The sum of  
what he has already done towards his party from  
Item. my Will is that I give & bequeath, for my Executrix  
Executive two hundred & thirty four pounds proclamation  
Money, or Virginias Money according to Buryard.
