 at the Discretion of my Executors nothing Doubting but at the Gods
 Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the Mighty Power
 of God and as touching what worldly Estate wheresoever I shall
 please God to bless me with in this Life I give and devise
 and dispose of the Same in the following Manner and Manner
 that is to say first of all I give and bequeath to my well beloved
 Wife my Bed and all my Household Furniture my bed Room
 two Chairs and bidle two boxes and boxes and my dwelling house
 during her Life and her Maintenance of the Plantation during
 her Life and at her Decease I give and bequeath my Plantation
 and Land that I now Possess being two Hundred Acres to my
 Son William and the Heirs of his Body and the remainder of my
 Estate to wit my House and Coors shall be equally divided
 in two equal parts to my two Children James M'Gowan
 John and William each of them to have alike this do make
 and Publish to be my last Will and Testament Raising and
 Disannulling and making Void all other Wills made before
 this and the same and I Train Grant Title to my Heirs and be
 Executor of this my last Will and Testament to see it executed
 according to the true intent thereof in Writings wheresoever I have
 written at my hand and Seal this Day of November in
 the year of our Lord God 1769

 Year of Our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy two
 make and Publish this my Last will & Testament in manner following
 First my Soul I Recommend to God who gave it and my Body to be
 Buried in a decent Christian like manner according to the Direction
 of my Executors and as touching what worldly Estate it has
 please the Lord to bestow upon me it is my will that it be Divided
 as follows and first it is my will that all Just Debt and
 Demands against me be Answered and fully Satisfied it is my
 will that a certain Plot or Tract of Land Situate on the Waters of Lake
 being the Vest of the Tract which I conveyed by Deed to Daughter
 Mary and her husband Mordcai Moss be sold to raise Money to
 Pay my Daughter as follows I give & bequeath to my Daughter
 Margaret forty Pounds to be paid when the money can be raised
 with Out Damage to the Estate also One good Mare & a side saddle
 and one fow and half also a Bed and bed Cloths and a Lorn and
 Washings and a Spinning wheel and to my Daughter Sarah
 I give and bequeath forty Pounds to be paid at such time as is
 Mentioned above for the payment of my Daughter Margarets
 Portion also a Colt one of the Mare I bequeathed to my Daughter
 Margaret as above also a side saddle and One Cow and calf
 also a bed & bed Cloths and a Spinning wheel also I give and
