an Attonement for my sins and is able to save to the
utmost all that come unto him in whom I trust he
will not neglect me a Returning Penitent whom I come to
him for Merit in this hope and confidence I Rend up my
Soul with comfort humbly trusting the most blessed and glorious
Trinity and God most holy most Merciful and Gracious
to prepare me for the time of my Dissolution and then to take
to himself into that place and rest which God hath prepared
for all them that love & fear his holy name, Amen — bless
to God Infirmities I give up my body to the Earth from
whence it was taken to be entred in a decent Christian manner
at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named not Doubt-
ing but that I shall Receive it again at the last Day
by the almighty power of God as to my worldly estate
wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me I will and
Ordain it in manner and form following to wit I give my
Funeral Expence and other Debts in full, the Remainder
of my Estate I will I bequeath in manner & form following
Item I Most fully give bequeath devise & demise my will
above signed Robert Baskin and half of my Estate Real
or Personal to him his Heirs & assigns forever.

and the other Morley or half I give bequeath devise & demise
unto my well beloved kinsman Adam Kinnear if he come to
America to him and his Heirs for ever but if he should not
come I give devise & demise the whole to the said Robert
Baskin to him his Heirs forever, and I do constitute and
appoint the above said Robert Baskin my loving Cousin
Executor of this my last will & Testament, and I do utterly revoke
Disannul & away every former, quinary and Disallow all former
Wills or Testaments to him by me heretofore made, and I do now
Publish declare & confirm this my last Will & Testament in
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my
Seal this Day month & Year first within written —
