

And also all my stock and household stuff except the House-
stead already delivered to my Children I give to her during her
life and at her pleasure to dispose of the same amongst the Chil-
dren. Also I give her my Mill during her life & after her death
to be sold and the money equally divided amongst all my
Children.

Item I give to my son John Joseph (aged) three hundred and
twenty acres of land, whereon he now lives, to him his heirs &
assigns forever.

Item I give to my son Thomas two hundred and ten acres
of land lying on both sides of Henley Mill Creek and running
to the land to him his heirs or assigns forever.

Item I give to my son Joseph one hundred and twenty acres of land that
I purchased of William Hendley to him his heirs or assigns forever.

Item I give to my son James two hundred and thirty and one
acres of land whereon I now live to him his heirs or assigns forever.
Provided nevertheless that he shall not deprive his mother
of living and it be lifetime and she desires it.

Item I give to my Daughter Elizabeth one hundred acres of
land which I purchased of Thomas Hendley to her her heirs
or assigns forever.

Item I give to my son Stephen two white cows whereof I am now
possessed.

I also hereby constitute & appoint my trusty Beloved Sons
Stephen Joseph & Joseph John my true and lawful Executors
of this my last will & Testament in things whereof I have here
to set my hand & affixed my Seal in the presence of us.
