 constitute ordain and declare this my last will and testament in manner
 and form following revoking and annulling by these presents all and every
 Testament and Testaments will and wills heretofore by me made and
 declared I make by word or writing and this is to be taken only for my
 Last will and Testament and no other and first humbly beseeching
 from the bottom of my heart for my sins past most humbly beseeching
 forgiveness for the same I give and commit my soul unto Almighty
 god my Saviour and Redeemer in whom and by the merits of Jesus
 Christ I trust and believe a sinners to be saved and to have full
 remission and forgiveness of all my sins and that my soul with my
 body at the general day of resurrection shall rise again with Joy and
 through the merits of Christ's death and passion pass and inherit the
 Kingdom of Heaven prepared for his Elect and Chosen and my body
 to be buried in such place where I shall please my Executors here
 after named to appoint and now for the settling of my temporal
 Estate and such goods Chattels and with as it hath pleased god

I have given my debts to be paid upon me first I give and bequeath to
 John Vaughan my dearly beloved wife all my Estate also I give
 and bequeath to her likewise Constable make and ordain my sole
 Executors and Administrators James Walker Executors and do hereby
 utterly disavow revoke and rescind all and every the former
 Testaments will legacies Bequests and Executors by me in any way
 before named willed and bequeathed ratifying and confirming this and
 no other to be my last will and testament in witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal this day and year above
 written signed sealed published pronounced and declared by the
 said John Vaughan as his last will and Testament in the
 presence of us all the Subscribers

 this my last will and testament in manner following and as touching
 such worldly Estate as it hath pleased god to bless me with I give devise

 I ordain and constitute my beloved wife Ann Nelson and William
 Nelson to be my whole and sole Executors of this my last will and
 Testament first I allow my loved wife a charge and debt to be paid
 out of my Estate I give and devise to my daughter Rachel five
 Shillings I give and devise to my daughter Rebecca five Shillings
 I give and devise to my daughter Ruth five Shillings
 I give and devise to my daughter Peter five Shillings

I give to my son Samuel Nelson five Shillings I give to my
Daughter Hannah five Shillings I also give and bequeath to my
wife Ann Nelson all the Remainder part of my Estate Viz.
a fine bed and biffer bed and furniture within the house hold plate stove
and hogs and what Notes are in my possession my big Bible horse and
Saddle In witness and testimony whereof I William Nelson have
set my hand affixed my seal this twenty fifth day of the 12th month and
in the year 1785

Memorandum of the last will and testament of
Sinnat Tate the Carpenters tools I leave to the discretion of my sons
of my son James the mill and vessels belonging to it to be jointly
in partnership between Samuel and George Tate the Serv^t known by
the name of George I give to my son George with a new Saddle and
Bridle and leave him under the Jurisdiction of his Brother James
to school them and rent out his part of the plantation to pay for the expenses
until he becomes of full age I leave him a bed and furniture the gear
I leave to Daughter Margaret in order she should have one also
I leave to my Daughter Elizabeth the mare known by the name of
Neva and to Lillie the black mare I had of Andrew Mitchell
I leave Sinnat his bay Colt that is now two and one year I leave the
mother of the above Colt to Margaret the horse called Brian I leave
to my son George I leave my son James red horse and his halfe Colt
the one that he had before I leave to my Daughter before my

Callise gown I leave to Betty my black gown I leave to Agnes as
much of the gown at her choice as the value of either of the above gowns - I
leave to my Daughter Sinnat to be put out at interest until she becomes
of age and to Margaret to be put out at interest for her use also and each of them
one Cow and half the Hubbard I leave to George the rest of the house
hold furniture I leave to the four younger Daughters to be Equally divided
between the four Daughters between Samuel and George the sum between
Samuel Nelson and me I leave between his own two Daughters
to be divided Equally between them and one Cow to his son David the
overplus I paid John Mitchell above his wife Tower I leave to his
Daughter Sinnat - I leave to Andrew Mitchell about one Cow and
half I leave to my Daughter Betty 1/2 - I desire and Request
Samuel Nelson to take Sinnat and Margaret under his care to
raise the I leave to my son James his Cow and after all debts and
charges is paid I leave my other Effects and money to my son George
and James oldest son if not a son to his oldest Daughter and I
nominate and appoint my son James Tate and Samuel Nelson
executors of my Estate this Memorandum I have signed sealed
