of Perfect Sense and memory, but knowing it is appointed me for
all men to die do think proper to make this my last will and
Testament in Manner and form following to wit First I
Principally I yield my Soul to god who gave it hoping through
the Merits of his Dear Son to obtain Pardon for all my sins and
my Body to be Buried in a Christian Manner at the Discretion
of my Executors and what Estate it hath pleased god to
send me after my Just debts be paid I give and Requith
as follows to wit, I then I give to my Son Robert Bryer that
Acres of Land on the Head of Barons Creek in Granville
County being 640 Acres and also my Negro man named
Will and what I have already given him and my account
against him on my Mock to him and his heirs Lawfully Right
to his Widow for Ever, I then I give to my Daughter Elizabeth
Housing all that I have already given to her and her heirs
Pardon as she Borrowed of me to her heirs for Ever, I then
I give to my Daughter Rhoda Stone my Negro man named
Pompy and two pairs of Shoes one Leather Head & Furniture on
Horn and Saddle what Estate she hath already received
to her and her heirs for Ever I then I give to my Daughter
Melinda Wamock my Negro named Frank & two Pairs and
Calves one Leather Head and Furniture one Horn and Saddle

all already Received to his heirs for Ever I then Give to my Daughter Elizabeth my Negro man named Harry and two Cows and Calves one Feather Bed and Furniture and one Horse and Saddle already Received to his heirs for Ever I then Give to my Grandson John Pryor Son to Green Pryor all that Land I purchased of Jacob Alday and also that Land I purchased of Robert M'Gibby both on May field and also my Negro woman named Sue and also my Negro Girl named Dinah also my Negro Girl Guda and their Increase and a Horse Saddle and two Cows Calves one Feather Bed and Furniture when he shall arrive to Twenty one years to him and his heirs for Ever which have already delivered to Green Pryor I then Give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Perkins my Negro woman named Mall and her Increase and two Cows Calves one Feather Bed and Furniture one Horse and Saddle already Received to her, his heirs for Ever I then Give to my Grand Daughter Betty Green Pryor my Negro Girl named Alley and her increase and also my tract of Land on Adams Creek adjoining Hugh Barnett when she shall arrive to Lawfull years or Marries to him and his heirs for Ever I then Give to my Daughter Rachael Pope my Negro Boy named Efeia one Feather Bed & Furniture two Cows and Calves one Young mare and Saddle what Estate she shall already Received to her her heirs for Ever I then Give to my daughter Dorothy Pryor my Negro Girl named Sue & one Feather Bed and Furniture two Cows Calves one Horse or Mare and Saddle when she arrives to Lawfull Age or Marries to him, and his heirs for Ever I then Give to my Daughter Anntha Pryor when she arrives to Lawfull Age or marries my Negro Boy named Ben and two Cows and Calves one Feather Bed & Furniture and horse or Mare & Saddle

to her and her heirs for Ever I then Give to my Son John Henry Pryor the Land and Plantation where I now dwell and also my Negro Girl named Phillis and two Cows and Calves one Feather Bed and Furniture and one young Horse and Saddle to him and his heirs for Ever, I then Give to my Son Abner Pryor all that Land I purchased of Frederick Kierlock and also that Land that Moses Walker owns and also that Land on Dicks as I bought the Improvements of Blackby Martin and also my Negro Boy named Cato and two Cows Calves and one Feather Bed and Furniture and one Horse & Saddle and also that tract of Land that I took up adjoining the Land I purchased of Frederick Kierlock to him and his heirs for Ever I then Give to my Grandson John Pryor Smith my Negro Girl named Violet and if she dies before she comes of Age then my will is that he be paid out of my Estate forty Pounds Virginia Money to him and his heirs for Ever, I also devise my tract of Land I purchased of Maria Tophy Junr 301 Acres on Flat River be sold and the Money divide amongst my Daughters and if Either of my Children should die before they come of Lawfull Age or Marries then their Estate both Real and Personal be Equally Divided amongst those of my Children as shall be then living and if Either of them Negroes above mentioned should die before the owner of them comes of Age or marries that then he be paid at their coming of Age or Marries out of my Estate forty Pounds Virginia Money and I bind to my wife Margaret Pryor During his Natural life or widowhood the use of my Plantation and where I now dwell and also and also the use of my Negroes Sam Marenah Paines Sam Jan Jada Jane Hannah Punch Captain In Newburn and my young Negro Kate not yet named in my will and also the use of my

Personal Estate to gather all my Stock of all kinds and two
Shells which Shells I gave to John Henry Poyer and Abner the
large one to John Henry Poyer and the Small one to Abner Poyer
and at the End of his life or widowhood my decess all
my Estate of what kind soever lent to my wife and
Executors lent to my wife as afore said be Equally
Divided amongst such of my Children as shall be then
living lastly I do appoint my son in law William Stone
and my son in law David Warnock and my wife
Margaret Poyer Executors & Co-authors of this my
last will & Testament Resting all other wills given
under my hand & That this 28th Day of September
1771

I David Pinter of North Carolina in the County of Orange and Parish
of Saint Matthews yeoman Being Very Sick and Weak in Body
Out of Perfect mind and memory that's be given unto god
therefore falling unto mine the mortality of my Body and knowing
that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and
Ordain this my last will and Testament that is to say
principally and first of all I gave and Recommend my soul
unto the hands of god that gave it and for my Body I commend
it to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like and decent Manner
at the discretion of my Executors Nothing Prejudging but at the
General Resurrection I shall Receive the Same again by the
mighty power of god and as Touching such worldly Estate
which with it hath pleased god to bless me in this life I give
Devise and Dispose of the Same in the following Manner
and form I p^rimiss it is my will and I do Order that in the
first place all my Just Debts and funeral Charges be Paid
and Satisfied - Item I give and Bequeath unto Margaret my dearly
Beloved wife the Bay Riding Mare and her Saddle & Bridle together
with her Bed and Bed clothes and her Mantinances ^{out} of the Estate
During her life if she do not marry But if she should
marry let her next Husband provide for her Item I give to
my well Beloved Son John Pinter the Stellen with the white
Mare and Sack Item I give to my two Sons William and
David Pinter the three Acres and Acreage for Ever all my
Plantation whereon I now dwell to be as Equally divided
Between them as Joseph Item I give to my daughter Martha
an Pound's Proclamation Money and the little Black Mare
when she comes to the Age of Eighteen Years and her
