 Money and they keep the Land & Bequeath to her on the
 other side and likewise it is my will and Desire that if
 any of my children should die before they have Lawfull
 heirs Byotten of those Orders that then what Land I have
 left it may Return to the others that have Lawfull heirs
 and be Equally divided amongst them Namely Elizabeth
 Priscilla Ezekiel & Lemmah to them & their heirs for Ever
 and after that if my Grandson dies with out Lawfull heirs
 then the Land I left him to fall to his mother as I said
 before on the other side I do appoint Ezekiel Harriston
 my son and Elkanah Harriston my son in law to be whole
 and sole Executors of this my Last will and Testament
 Disannulling and making void all other wills and Testaments
 here after by me made Inwrit to be my Last in
 witness whereof I have here unto set my hand this 8th
 day of October 1772

 die do Make and Ordain this my Last will & Testament that
 is to Say Principally and first of all I give and Recommend
 my Soul into the hands of God that gave it and for my
 Body I recommend it to the Earth to be buried in a Christian
 and Decent manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing
 Doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall Receive the
 same again by the mighty Power of God and as Touching such
 Worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me
 in this life I give devise and Dispose of the same in the following
 manner and form — I certify it is my will and Desire
 that in the first Place all my Just debts be paid and funeral
 Charges Satisfied, Item I give and Bequeath unto Catharine my
 Dearly Beloved wife all the Money that now is in Joseph Allensons
 and in Pasture Ruthersons hands and she is to dispose of it at
 her death among our children as she thinks proper and she
 is to have Phillis to herself while she lives and she is to give
 Phillis at her death to Joseph Allerson and she is to have
 the little Servant Man and his Coll and his Saddles & what
 Meats and Bread & clothes is in the House and the Dresser and
 Potts what she pleases to keep of them and two Cows and what
 Grain she pleases to have for her use and the use of her
 cattle and two Cows and two weathers and what House hold
 Furniture and Utensils she pleases to keep to herself
 and ten Pound Virginia Money I then I give to my

To my well beloved Son William Rea all my Plantations and all and singular the Lands now live on to him his heirs and assigns for Ever to Lutter with all my Staves Hens and Sheep and the Negroes fellow Starling and the Waggon and the Quintation of it together with all the moveables on the Plantation and what Money Remains after paying the Legacies I have to my Son William Rea—

Item I give to my Beloved Grandson David Rea the Two Hundred Acres of Land that I purchased last to him his heirs and assigns for Ever Item I give to my Son in Law Michael Robinson my Negroes Bay Major to him and his heirs & assigns for Ever—

Item I give to my Son in Law John Marsh the five Pounds that is in his own hand never to be taken from him Item I give to my Son in Law James Marsh all the money that he owes me never to be demanded from him, Item I give to my daughter Son in Law Bartholomew five Pounds to be given him by my Son William And Joseph Allison and my Son William Rea— I make and Avow my only and Sole Executors of this my last will and Testament And do here by disallow revoke and disannul all and Ever other former Testaments Wills and Legacies and Executors by me in any way before this time named written and Requisites Ratified and Confirming this no other to be my last will and Testament In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the Day Year above written

One Hundred & Twenty Acres to continue her Right and Property
During the time of her Widowhood and at her Marriage
or death the Land to be sold and the Money Divided Equally
Amongst all my children Item I bequeath to my Beloved
Wife all my Moveables that is to say all my Stock of
Swine Cows Sheep Hogs I also do constitute and Appoint my
Beloved wife Mary Allen Sole Executrix to this my last
will and Testament here by Revoking & disannulling all former
Wills Testaments & or Requisites by me made and
