The condition of the above bill of sale is such that if the above Asa Blake do and shall pay of and discharge the said bond of Two hundred and thirtyfive pounds three shillings and sixpence and receive a receipt in full for the same from I. Phillips and Wray and discharge the said James Blake from his security ship then this obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue

To all Christian people to whom these presents come I John Edwards send greeting in manner and everlasting know ye that I John Edwards for and in consideration of the love good will and affection which I have to and bear towards my loving friend Margaret Edwards of Orange County have given and granted and by these presents before me have heartily and absolutely given and grant to the said Margaret Edwards during her lifetime and at her death unto her son Henry Edwards his heirs and executors a certain Negro boy named aged eleven years named Socorsato me belonging and which I may justly claim as in right my own whether alive or dead to have and to hold the said negro unto the said Margaret Edwards and at her decease unto her son Henry Edwards and his heirs for ever and from hence forth as her property and at her death to her son Henry Edwards his heirs executors and assigns and their proper good forever absolutely without any manner of condition I the said John Edwards have absolutely and of my own accord set and put in further testimony in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the sixteenth day of June in the Ninth year of the independence of the United States and in the year of our Lord god one thousand seven hundred and eighty six
