and there furniture and two better Dishes the four
Wheat and meat and mease to be sold and all
the Effects in and about the House and the money
is to be collected By Bishop Munkley and David Stetha
Appointed my Executors to Pay of as far as my
Estate is Indebted and the Remainder to my well
Beloved two Sisters Esther Robinson & Ellenor (Camp

be my last will & Testament

Ruth a mare Colt I order all the Remainder Part of my
Goods & Chattels to be Equally Divided amongst my four
youngest Daughters Jane, Sarah, Elizabeth, & Ruth
I do constitute and appoint my Beloved wife and my
Son Alexander my Soul Executors of this my last will
and Testament in trust for the Intent to and Purpose
