I Charles Foshier of the County of Orange, being very  
Sick & Weak and being but of perfect & sound mind &  
Memory thanks be to God, therefore (calling) to mind the  
Mortality of my body & that it is appointed for all men once  
to die, do make & ordain this my last will & Testa-  
ment, that is to Say principally I fear of all. I commend  
my Soul unto the hands of Almighty who gave it &  
my body I commit to the earth, to be buried in a Christian  
like & Decent manner at the discretion of my Executors  
Nothing doubting, but the General Resurrection I shall  
enjoy the same again, by the mighty power of God.  
I as touching such worldly Estate wherewith I hold  
pleased Almighty God to bless me with in this life I  
give & devise thereof in the following manner. I give.

Impremise, I leave unto Susanna my dearly beloved  
Wife, every thing I have during her widowhood, if ever  
she marries I will but off to her thirds & there the Land  
to be Equally Divided between my two Sons, William  
Foshier & Charles Foshier, every thing else that I  
have, to be sold for money & Equally Divided -  
amongst my Children.

of Cattle Hogs & horses, to her and her heirs forever.

Item I do Constitute & appoint my Loving Wife  
Priscilla Executor of this my last Will & Testament.

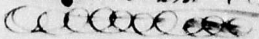

Copy of: In the name of God amen I James Rogers of  
Orange County North Carolina in the County seat of B. Co.  
last of August 1769, do make this my last will & Testa-  
ment. First I commend my soul unto God who gave it -  
& my Body to be buried by Christian Burial. I do give & bequeath  
the Division of my Estate to I appoint Hugh Rogers & Angel Rogers  
my Executors after my Decease, to see my will & Testament  
fulfilled. I appoint all my Just Debts to be paid & I -  
allow my wife amand with all the & as much & more & a  
pinning Wheel & Bed that has feathers in it & Bed & clothes &  
other furniture in Money &c. I allow my Daughter Mary  
& the Child that my wife is with me of a Boy, to have two -  
parts of a Girl, to be equal Shewers & if any of the Children  
die their part is to be given to the next best surviving to  
be equally divided to my Brothers I desire Edmund & I -  
allow all my movable Estate to be sold & more into Money  
& to be paid to Mary & all to buy and Estate in part to  
be retained for the use of the Children till they come of age -  
& then shall be for the Maintenance of my wife & Children -  
During her being my Widow & afterwards to be given to the  
Children for their Maintenance & Schooling & if the Child.

that my wife is with her a Boy after being made agreed & settled -  
he is to be put, to abide at the Direction of my Executors. I also  
my Daughter Mary I allow her a certain & best & new & show  
to her Shewers, with her Linnen, only was to remain for the  
use of the family. I allow to Brothers John & William  
a hat. I give a Silver Pocket Watch to Brother William a Boy  
coat. I give each of them a pair of Shewers, & I allow  
my Brother Hugh to be my Administrator & James Williams  
Rogers & Robert Rogers to be Guardians over this my Estate to see  
that my Will is fulfilled. I allow my Brother Edmund & John Rogers  
& Angel & 1/10 of Black Dutch Stockings & Shewers & that  
I acknowledge this my last will & Testament in Witness
