Belovd Son William Smith whom I do will constitute make and  
Ordain my only and sole Executor of thy my last Will and  
Testament all and singular the House & Improvement with one Horse  
and Young Haire with all the Rest of the Cattle and of the Sheep with  
the Remainder of the House hold Planching and Hogs with all and  
Every thing Belonging to the same to him his heirs and assigns for  
ever and I do hereby utterly disallow Procke & Disannul all and  
Every other former Testaments wills & legacies and Executors by  
me in any ways before this time named willd & Beguathid
