(commonly called August. in the Year of our Lord One thousand
Seven hundred & Eighty five. Being, partly of Body yet of
perfect mind & memory, shew to God One thousand —
that it is Appointed, for all ones and to Dye, I do make
& Ordain this my last will & Testament & as touching
such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to bless me
with, in this my last Disposal of in the following manner.
First I Ordain & bequeath William Piggott & Jeremiah
Piggott to be my only & sole Executors & Administrators of this my
last will & Testament. Follow my funeral Charges &
Cost Ditt to be paid paid out of my Estate.

Also I give to Benjamin, unto my Beloved Wife Elizabeth
 all my household furniture & my Horse & Carriage. —
 I bequeath unto my Beloved wife Elizabeth, I leave
 possession of all my real Estate unto my eldest son Robert

 to pay my youngest son & his twenty pounds out of the
 Estate, when he comes to the age of twenty and I leave the —

 Mom I also leave & devise unto my Beloved wife all the
 remaining part of my household Estate not yet mentioned
 to be at her wife's Request & Disposal as an additional help
 together with the Comfort I have allowed her my beloved wife
 to have out of my real Estate to raise my Children as
 I wish until they come of age in which I solemnly
 bind if I have Decendants at my hand I Seal the Day &
 Year first above Written
