 September 1785 I John Vaughan of Orange County being sick in body
 but good and perfect memory thanks be to Almighty god and calling to
 remembrance the uncertain Estate of this Transitory life and that all
 flesh must yield unto death when it comes shall please god to call to make
 constitute ordain and declare this my last will and testament in manner
 and form following revoking and annulling by these presents all and every
 Testament and Testaments with and with heretofore by me made and
 declared either by word or writing and this is to be taken only for my
 Last will and Testament and none other and first humbly and sorrow
 from the bottom of my heart for my sins past most humbly desiring
 forgiveness for the same I give and commit my soul unto Almighty
 god my Saviour and Redeemer in whom and by the merits of Jesus
 Christ I trust and believe a Saviour to be saved and to have full
 remission and forgiveness of all my sins and that my soul with my
 body at the general day of resurrection shall rise again with my
 Saviour the merits of Christ's death and passion to help and inherit the
 Kingdom of Heaven prepared for his Elect and Chosen and my body
 to be buried in such place where it shall please my Executors here
 after named to appoint and now for the settling of my temporal
 Estate and such goods Chattels and with as it hath pleased god

I have given my debts to be paid upon me first I give and bequeath to
 John Vaughan my dearly beloved wife all my Estate also I give
 I give unto her I likewise constitute make and ordain my sole
 Executor and likewise James Mathew Executors and do hereby
 utterly disallow revoke and annul all and every other former
 Testaments with Legacies Bequests and Executors by me in any way
 before named made and bequeathed ratifying and confirming this and
 no other to be my last will and testament in due proof whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal this day and year above
 written signed sealed published pronounced and declared by the
 said John Vaughan as his last will and Testament in the
 presence of us all the Subscribers
