 of the County of Orange Planter being very sick and
 weak in Body but of perfect mind and memory thanks
 be given to God therefore all calling to mind the
 Mortality of my body and knowing that is appointed
 to all men once to die do make and Ordain this my
 last will and Testament I Give principally and first
 I Give and recommend my Soul into the hands
 of God that gave it, my body I recommend it to the
 earth to be buried in a Christian like and Decent
 manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but
 at the General resurrection I shall receive the same again by
 the mighty power of God and as touching my worldly estate
 wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life, I Give
 and dispose of the same in the following manner
 I Give and bequeath to Elizabeth my Dearest beloved
 wife pleasure possession of my house and Negroe Sel, during
 her widowhood one bed & furniture my Young Sonnel Man
 and two Cows & Calves and the Seventh part of my household
 Furniture, but if she marries the Negroe to be divided as
 the rest, I Give to my beloved Sons David & Joseph
 Allison One tract of Land whereon I now live and my
 Lands

Lands on Quaker River to be divided according to Quantity
 and Quality my Wagon and Team to be left on my
 plantations for the Use and benefit of my family and
 my Son David to have the Care of my plantations
 for the support of my family and an advantage
 to himself I Give and bequeath to my Son David
 John Thompson five Shillings — I Give and bequeath
 to my Son in Law Aaronish Thompson five Shillings
 I Give and bequeath to my Son in Law Samuel
 Woods, one Cow & Calf — the rest of my
 personal and real estate to be equally divided between
 David Allison, Margaret Joseph, Mary, Sarah,
 Vanny Allison Excepting Negroes, & an, and
 her offspring which is not to be divided till
 my youngest Child comes of Age and I do hereby
 constitute make and Ordain Elizabeth Allison
 David Allison and John Thompson my only
 and sole Executors of this my last will & Testament
 all and singular the Lands Mises & as Lands and
 Tenements to them their Heirs and assigns forever
 and I do hereby utterly revoke & disannul all and every other
 former Testaments Wills Legacies & Executors in any
 by me before mentioned Wills and bequeaths ratifying
 this and no other to be my last will and Testament
 In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand & seal, the day and year above written

Lands on Duck River to be divided according to Quantity and Quality my Waggon and Team to be left on my plantations for the Use and benefit of my family and my Son David to have the Care of my plantations for the support of my family and an advantage to himself I Give and bequeath to my Son in Law John Thompson five Shillings — I Give and bequeath to my Son in Law Asariah Thompson five Shillings — I Give and bequeath to my Son in Law Samuel Woods one Cow & Half — The rest of my personal and real estate to be equally divided between David Allison, Margaret Joseph, Mary, Sarah, & Nancy Allison excepting a Negroes, a Van, and her offspring which is not to be divided till my youngest Child comes of Age and I do hereby constitute make and Ordain Elizabeth Allison, David Allison and John Thompson my only and Sole Executors of this my last will & Testament and singular the Lands Missuages Lands and Tenements to them their Heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby utterly revoke & disannul all and every other former Testaments Wills Legacies & Executors in any way by me before mentioned Wills and bequeathed ratifying this and no other to be my last will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the day and year above written

In the Name of God Amen I William Clarke being sick and weak but of perfect sound memory do make and constitute this my last Will and Testament Resolving after this will or Wills heretofore by me made in the first place I recommend my body to the dust from whence it came to be buried in a Christian manner at the discretion of my Executor hereafter mentioned and my soul to Almighty God from whence it came having a hope in the resurrection Jesus Christ my Redeemer, as to my worldly he has been pleased to give me, I will and devise in manner and form following I Give and bequeath unto George Daniel of Orange County and State of North Carolina all my worldly goods real and personal and money due me by Notes or accounts whatsoever for his trouble and care of me to him and his Heirs forever I do hereby make and constitute Samuel Daniel, my Executor to this my last Will and Testament as witness my hand & Seal this twenty fifth day of July in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Eighty nine signed sealed & declared in the presence of us
