In the name of God Amen the seventeenth
of January 1792 I Christopher Barber being sick in
my last Will Testament in manner and form
following first ~~being~~ penitent and sorry
for all my sins most humbly desiring for
pardon for the same I commend my soul
to almighty God my saviour and Redeemer
and by whose merits I trust to be saved
to have full Pardon and forgiveness

Of all my sins and to inherit the Kingdom
Heaven and my Body I commit to the Earth
to be decently buried at the discretion of my
executors here after named and for the settling
my temporal Estate and such Goods & chattels
Debts as it shall please God to bestow upon
me I do order and give and dispose of the same
in manner and form following that is to say
I give and bequeath unto my Wife
Barber all my Estate during her life or widow
hood and if she has a son I give him the
and plantation whereon I now live to have
to take possession at twenty one years age
and if not & she should marry I give and be-
queath all my Estate to be divided between
my Wife and all my Girls my Wife one share

and a half and each Girl a share but if
she should ^{not} marry and should have a son
the son to have the Land as before mentioned
and an equal share with Girls and I there-
by make and appoint my loving
Friends John Barber and Joseph Barber
shall and sole Executors of this my last Will
and Testament in Writings whereof I have
executed set my hand ~~and seal~~ the day
and date as above written
