

Received Hillsborough February the Eighteenth 1793
 from John Craven late Treasurer of the Board of Trustees
 of the University of North Carolina the Sum of Five
 thousand and fifty eight pounds eleven shillings
 and ten pence current Money. Vouchers for cash paid
 the Printers and commissioners, for fixing on the
 plan whereon the University is to be erected includ-
 ing one hundred pounds advanced Mr John Ragon
 for Brick) to amount of One hundred Fifty three
 pounds Six Shillings Six pence, Certificate granted
 by the commissioners of Loans for funded Certificate
 to amount of one thousand and eighty two pounds
 eleven shillings and nine pence, & Char'd Dollars
 for the Interest, on the funded Certificate from
 January the first 1792 to December the thirty first
 in the same year, Ninety nine dollars (and
 twenty two Cents, and Grants for twenty Thousand
 Acres of Western Lands, given to the University by
 Col Benjamin Smith, all of which appear to be
 in full of John Cravens Account as rendered to me
 from August 1792 at which time he made
 a settlement with the Trustees up to the present
