 I give Demise and dispose of in the following manner
 I give and bequeath unto my loving son Abraham
 Davis and his heirs for ever my tract of Land
 on Snowsloe and also one Bay Horse having
 the name of Prince and also I give and bequeath
 my son Abraham Davis my two slaves named by the
 Names of Ty and Bill

I give and bequeath unto my loving son William
 Davis one hundred Acres of Land beginning at a
 Cedar Cornix Tree running with Dickses Lane to
 make the above one hundred Acres to have the rest
 of the Tract of mountainous Land as little as possible
 I give and bequeath unto my loving Daughter
 Morder Parker my Looking Glass to her and her
 heirs for ever
 I give and Bequeath all the rest of my Estate unto
 my four Loving Daughters and my loving son
 John Davis to be equally divided between
 them after my last Debts are paid
 And I do likewise constitute and appoint
 my loving son Abraham Davis my sole
 Executor to this my last Will and Testament
 I do hereby utterly Disannul and Disallow
 all other Wills heretofore made by me as this
 with my hand and seal this the ninth Day
 of January 1792
