perfect understanding and memory do ordain constitute
and appoint this my last will & Testament
First I most humbly begueth my soul to God my maker
trusting his most gracious acceptance of it through all
the sufficient merits and mediation of my most
precious redeemer Jesus Christ. I give my body to the
Earth from whence it was taken in full assurance of
its resurrection from thence at the last Day as for
my Burial I desire it may be decent without pomp
or state of the discription of my Dear Wife, and
my Executors hereafter named who I doubt not, will
manage it with all requisite prudence, as for
my personal Estate I will and positively order that
all my Debts be paid, first I give unto my Dear Loving
Wife for the term of her life this House where I now
dwell with her bed & furniture thereto belonging I give
and bequeath unto my Son James and Stewart, the Land I
now live on, also I give and bequeath to my son Robert
and William the Plantation I formerly lived on, and further
I order and allow my Executors to value said Land and
make an equal divide with my son Thomas, & I will and
bequeath to my Daughter Polly one Horse & Saddle worth
thirty Pounds also Cows and a feather bed & furniture
and one Chest, and further I give to my wife one equal
share of all the personal property which is to be sold
or valued at the discretion of my Executors I also ordain
and hereby nominate and appoint my well beloved
Wife Nancy & Stewart Executors

of this my last Will and Testament and give them full
 Power to sell and make and equal divide of
 the Personal Property to my Wife & five Sons
 Thomas, James, Stewart, Robert & William after
 giving my Daughter Polly her Portion off
 first, I also give and allow my Daughter Mary
 out of my monies due five pounds and hereby
 revoking all Will & Wills by me heretofore made

 me with I bequeath give and devise in manner follow-
 First I allow my funeral Charges to be paid out of my
 Estate I Ordain or constitute my two Sons George & Peter
 Foust my whole and sole Executors of this my last will
 and Testament

I give to my Son Philip Foust five Shillings
 I give to my Son John Foust five Shillings
 I give to my Son Jacob Foust five Shillings
 I give to my Son Christian Foust five Shillings
 I give to my Son George Foust five Shillings
 I give to my Daughter Barbara Clap five Shillings
 I give to my Daughter Judith Clap five Shillings
 I give and bequeath to my well beloved wife Barbara
 Foust a feather Bed, Bedstead & furniture and my
 Walnut Chest and all her wearing Cloaths and to have
 her living and maintenance on the Plantation &
 to live on during the time she remains my widow
 with full privilege of the Store room Orchards &c
 and after her decease the Bed Bedstead & furniture
 to be equally divided between my three youngest Sons
 George, Peter & Daniel Foust, but her wearing Cloaths
 she may dispose of to her own mind
 I give to my two youngest Sons Peter & Daniel Foust
 all the Land that I now live on Peter is to have the half
 of the Old Tract to be taken of the East end and Daniel to have
 the improvement and part I now live on, and they the said
 Peter & Daniel shall divide the new tract to their liking
 provided they pay to my Son Jacob Foust each of them
 ten pounds, Which I give to my two Sons Peter & Daniel
 Foust my smith tools to be equally divided between them
 all the remaining part of my perishable Estate is to be
 equally divided between my three Sons George Peter & Daniel
 I give to my son George Foust my large Bible In witness
 thereof I John Foust have hereunto set my hand & Seal this
 first day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
 hundred & Eighty six, Signed & Sealed in the presence of us
