 say Principally and first of all I give & recom-
 mend my soul into the hands into the hands of the
 Almighty God that gave it and my body. I recom-
 mend to the Earth, from whence it came to be buried
 in decent christian burial at the Discretion of
 my Execution nothing doubting but the general
 Resurrection I shall receive the same again by
 the mighty power of god and as touching
 such worldly Estate where with it was
 pleased God bless me with in this Life
 I give demise in and Dispose of the same in
 the following manner & form, I give to my
 beloved wife my Land & plantation whereon
 I now live Horses & Cattle & Hogs & household
 Furniture, during her Natural Life and after
 her Decease to my son Nathaniel farmer
 one Hundred Acres of Land In my Neigh-
 bour

to my son James Farmer 90 Acres of Land and
 Plantation whereon I now live, and the house-
 hold Furniture to be Equally Divided betwixt
 Anne Farmer & Brucille Farmer, the stock to
 be Equally Divided amongst the two sons
 & two Daughters. I do Appoint my beloved
 wife & Daniel Green, my Executors I shew
 my hand & Seal in the presence of
