to mind that all mankind is born once to Die. I do hereby
Constitute this my last Will and Testament, and
that I do Will and bequeath my soul unto Him who

It has been pleased to bestow upon me I do Will
the following manner and form, First.
I do allow all my Debts to be paid out of
my moveable Estate. I will unto my Daughter
Rebecca Hall five Shillings I will unto my Son
William Hall five Shillings I will unto my Daughter
Mary Nichols five Shillings I will unto my
John Hall six pounds the above Legacies
of the Currency of North Carolina } The Residue
of my property both my Land and personal Estate
shall be Divided as followeth after my Death
all to be valued by two or three honest Men and
to be Divided into four Shares I allow my son
John Hall two Shares I allow my Daughter Sarah
Hall one share I allow my Daughter Rachel
Hall one share and I allow my son Thomas Hall the
remaining 4th share I allow my Son Robert
Hall to keep the above six pence and Rachel Hall
part of the Land if he thinks proper paying
for the present according to each of their
parts But I allow my Son Thomas Hall to keep
his part of the Land if he thinks proper but if
he shall take the present from his Brother

Robert if his Brother wants to keep it but if
he shall be at Liberty to sell it to whom he
pleases I make and constitute this my
Will and Testament I make and declare
all other Wills whatsoever I suppose and con-
