last Will and Testament that is to say principally
and first of all I give and Recommend my soul
to the hand of Almighty God that gave it
and my Body I Recommend to the Earth to be Buried
in decent Christian Burial at the dis-
cretion of my Executors - Nothing doubting
but at the general Resurrection I shall Re-
ceive the same again by the mighty power
of God and as touching such worldly estate
where with it has pleased God to bless me
in this life I give Devise and dispose of the
same in the following manner and form
I Give Young Kiny Horn son of Joshua
Horn my Bed and Furniture not to lose
it till of Age and besides twenty Pounds
of Lawful Money and my son Thomas Horn

Jun Bed and furniture and housefurnish
and twenty pounds Lawful money of the
State and besides to young Kiny Horn
I give and bequeath to him a Cow and half and
Horn Daughter of James Horn I give and bequeath
to her five pounds and her Mother Margery
pounds in which I all the rest of my Estate
Remains after this Legacy and Zitted and Zitted
to my son Thomas Horn I give and bequeath
to him what ever remains and I do hereby Disallow
Puske and Disannul all and every other former
testaments Wills Legacies and Executors by me in
wise before named Will and bequeath ratify
ing and Confirming this and no other to be my
last Will and Testament in things where
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 10th
day of April in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand
eight hundred and Ninety two
Signed sealed published pronounced
and declared by me Thomas Horn
as his last Will & Testament in the
presence of us who in his presence
and in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed
our names
