

In the name of God almighty I William Jamison being in a low state of health but of sound mind and memory calling to mind the great uncertainty of this mortal life have made and Ordained this my last Will and Testament as follows (to wit) Imprimis I give and bequeath to my Daughter Rachell Jamison one Soverne Mow of a chist of Draw One Bed and furniture and one Cow and Calf to her and her heirs forever.

Item I bind to my beloved Wife Rachell Jamison the use of my land and plantation whereon I now live Also the use of my Stock of Horses Cattle Sheep and Hogs, the use of my working tools and household furniture except what I have bequeathed to my Daughter Rachell during her natural life Next I give and bequeath to my Son John Jamison after my Wife Rachell Jamisons death the land and plantation that I now live on but the same that I have left to my beloved Wife Rachell to him and his heirs forever provided however the said John Jamison gives an Orphan Boy that was found to me by the name of James Jamison one years schooling.

Item it is my Will and desire that after the death of my beloved Wife Rachell that the remain of what I have left her (except the Land and plantation) shall be equally divided

I bequeath my Children Eliza Jamison, Thomas Jamison, William Jamison, John Jamison, Rachel Jamison, Mary Parks, and Margaret Lindsey to them and their heirs forever.

I Nominate and appoint my friend Sterling Harris to be the Executor of this my last Will and Testament In witness whereof I have published and declared this to be my last will and Testament wherfore I have set my hand and affixed my seal the 13th day of March 1792
