

I know all men by these presents that I John Morgan of the County & State aforesaid being rendered through bodily infirmities incapable of transacting my own business as I could wish to repose special trust and confidence in my truly friend John Grant Preacher of said County have nominated constituted and appointed and by these presents do nominate constitute and appoint him my lawful Agent and attorney to transact and settle all my business both in Law and Equity and do empower him to settle either at publick or private Sale or of any property either real or personal which I have not already given to my Children he shall in the most beneficial manner raise money to pay disburse and discharge my lawful debts and other business arising thereon I shall acknowledge by these presents and Deed of Gift or Sale given for such property sold by my agent or attorney as good and sufficient in Law as if I myself was to do the same, I also empower my said Agent or Attorney to manage my Domestic Affairs as to the management of my Plantations or Plantations & to employ any Person he shall think fit for an Overseer of my Negroes and to provide whatever is necessary for the use of my Plantation Stock and family and to demand sue for recover & receive any sum or sums of Money which are now or may be due me and to pay and give receipts for the same as fully and effectually as I myself could do if I myself was present in all things to carry on my business

he shall think most conducive to my Honor and wellfare and that of my family and I do hereby Obligate myself and my Heirs to amply and fully satisfy and reward him for whatever trouble and expence he shall be at in transacting my business In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this third day of March 1791 John Morgan

 or Deem any suit or suits relative to the demands
 aforesaid also to execute and make proper disbursements
 and receipts for all moneys on the accounts
 aforesaid, and finally I do authorize my said Attorney
 = my for the purposes aforesaid and by the
 Authority aforesaid to have Execute & do all
 Acts Deeds and Things lawfully which by Law
 appertain to Attorneys or Agents ratifying all same
 and holding for firm and effectual all and singular,
 I do promise therefore set forth in

 it is appointed for all men Once to die I do hereby
 constitute ratify and confirm this my Last Will &
 Testament — That is to say first I will I recommend
 my Soul and body into the hands of Almighty God
 who first gave them, to be buried in a Christian
 manner at the discretion of my Executors hoping
 in the Blood and Merits of Jesus Christ at the
 General Resurrection of the Dead to Receive the
 largeness of my life through Jesus Christ our Lord
 I do hereby give and bequeath of the same in the
 following manner and form, I will I give and
 bequeath to my beloved Wife Mary Rhodes the
 Part of my Estate I am now possessed with consisting
 of Land Horses Cattle Hogs & all other household
 furniture & the other part to be equally divided
 between my three Children, Hannah Rhodes Elizabeth
 Rhodes & Alexander Rhodes to them their Heirs & assigns
 forever, — and I do Appoint my loving Wife Mary
 Rhodes & my Sister Aquilla Rhodes as Executors
 of this my Last Will and Testament Repealing &
 disannulling all other & former Wills & Testaments
 by me made —
