last Will and Testament: That is to say, first
I give and Recommend
my Soul unto the hands of Almighty God
who gave it and my Body to the Earth to be buried
in decent Christian Burial at the discretion
of Executors nothing doubting but at the great
Resurrection I shall receive the same again.
The Almighty power of God and I do hereby
appoint my dear ly beloved son William Lockhart
and James Parker my son in law reading
Executors in this my last Will and Testament
And as touching such Worldly Estate whome
it hath pleased God to bless me with in this

life, I give Demise and dispose of the same
the following manner and Form
I give and bequeath unto my dear ly beloved son
William Lockhart the dwelling House square and Lot
upon Snow Lane in possession of with every
this Part and Partment thereunto belonging
Also I give and bequeath unto my ly
belov'd Daughters to wit Catherine Roads
John Holt Garret Parker Elizabeth Micklejohn
Mary Smith all and every thing of my mo-
vable property together with what sum or sums
of Money what may be in Reserve and also Debts that
I or hereafter may be Due after my decease to be equally
divided amongst the aforesaid Catherine Roads
John Holt Garret Parker Elizabeth Micklejohn and
Mary Smith. And I do utterly disallow Purcell and
annull all and every other former Testaments
of my said Bequests and Executors by me
any ways before Name William
Lockhart and James Parker
witnessing and confirming this and no other to be

my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 25th day
of August in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred and Eighty set
signed published pronounced
and sealed by me the said Catharine Lockhart
Lockhart as her last Will and Testament in the presence
of us who in his presence and in the presence of each other
