form following first I give and bequeath to my  
loving wife Margaret the plantation wheron  
she liveth during her life or widow hood and after  
her death it is my desire that it falls to my son  
William the better to enable her to raise her children  
I give her all my household furniture and working tools  
and one certain Gray Horse and one Bay Mare  
than Cows & Calves of the first choice of my Stock in  
full of my Stock of Hogs & Sheep

I give and bequeath to my son John part of that  
tract of Land wheron he now lives begining  
a post Oak on the Quaker Road the old bridle  
path running to the ford of the Creek between him  
and his brother James and so on the out side but  
also Sixty Acre of Land that I bought of Mr. Ayre  
adjoining Peter Woolf & James Campbell for  
which he must pay twenty four pounds

being contipeated to the said Lytle  
item I give and bequeath to my Son James the  
beginning part of that tract of Land wheron my  
son John lives and known by the plantation where  
Daniel McWay formerly lived also one other tract  
of Land that I bought of James Willidong and  
honor my son James now lies after I give and  
bequeath to my son Eli one other Tract of land  
bought of James Willidong of one hundred and thirty  
acres adjoining the land of Peter woolf also one Bull  
one Horse & saddle one Colt called Duke one Cow & half  
a peck of Corn - Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth one  
cow more one cow - Item I give and bequeath  
to my Daughter Savannah one Colt called Prince  
Item I give and bequeath to my Son William one boy  
that is called his. It is my desire that my  
Wife shall make up to her two youngest Daughters  
what shall be equal to what I have left to my other  
Daughters when they come of age out of what I  
my wife and then if there should be any thing  
left at her Death It is my desire that it be equally  
divided between my four daughters  
the rest of my property I desire that it be sold by my  
executors at publick sale at least so much of it as  
will pay all my debts and if it should not take all  
I have not given away it is then my desire that  
all fall into the stock of my wife She divided at her  
death between my Son William & my four Daughters  
I appoint my wife Margaret my Executrix and my Son  
John Executor of this my last will & Testament

and hereby revoke all other Will or Wills whereto  
I have herunto set my hand & seal this 20<sup>th</sup> day of April 1789

Do make and Ordain this my last will and Testament. That is to say first especially and first of all I give and recommend my soul into the hands of God that gave it and my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like and decent manner at the discretion of my Executors, not doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life

give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form Impromis it is my will & I do desire that in the first place all my just debts and funeral charges be paid and satisfied Item I do allow unto Rosanna my Dearly beloved wife her young during life of my Estate. Item I give and bequeath to my beloved son Robert Marley one Lot lying in Newport - Item I give to my beloved son Sam Marley & his wife Duglass Hannah White Nancy Call Robert Marley's son Robert Adam, and my son Adam Marley's son Peter to each and every one of them five pounds the Children part not to pay till they come of age. I give unto my well beloved son Samuel Marley whom I likewise constitute and appoint my whole and sole executor of this my last will and

Testament, and all and singular the Lands my possessions & heretofore bequeathed to them his heirs and assigns forever, and for all manner of debts, legacies and bequests whatsoever I do hereby utterly disallow Rents and disannul all and every other former Testament Wills Legacies and Testaments made by me any way before this named will bequeathed setting this and no other to be my last will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day and year above written signed sealed published pronounced and declared by the said Adam Marley as his last will and Testament In the presence of us the subscribers his Executors
