John Moore Junr of the County of Orange and State of North Carolina, being through the abundance given and bounties mercies of God though weak in body yet living full and perfect understanding and memory do Constitution this my last will and Testament and make it as Constitution and witness that it may be known by all as such. And first I heartily beseech my soul to God my maker to give my body to the earth fresh whence it was, in full assurance of its resurrection from thence at the last judgment at dissolution of my dear friends as to my own Estate I will and specifically order that all my debts be paid first I give to myself and living wife for the turn of her life this House wherein I now dwell with the furniture and one third of the Land, a plantation for her life and after her death to my only son & Rachel my young boy not exceeding with one third of the cattle I give to my son Rachel the plantation wherein she now dwells with an obligation for her to pay all her charges against spring and also half yearly for her cattle lastly I give to my Daughter Elizabeth one and twelve acres and a house and furniture with one third of the cattle and fifty pounds in money the remainder of my money that is in my Name and what is due before to be paid to be divided in good hands and to be equally divided between my son and Daughter I constitute my Trusty friend James Moore and David Turnstine Executors of my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this 24th day of October anno Domini 1790

John Lindsey of the County of Orange and State of North Carolina planter being weak in body but perfect mind and memory thank be given unto God having in mind the mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men to die I call and Ordain this my last will and Testament that is to say principally and first of all I give and command my soul into the hand of Almighty God that gave it and my Body I command to the earth to lie in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but the general resurrection shall occur the same again by the mighty power of God as touching my earthly Estate wherewithal I have left to God to dispose in the life I give direction and disposition of the same in following manner and form than my Will is that all my test debts be paid before I leave to my wife beloved wife Mary Lindsey the sum of one fourth part of all the Land wherein I now live the dwelling house the stock of all kind all the negroes and all the Household and plantation utensils and that my well beloved Daughter Zilla Lindsey has the knowledge of the said house and the land and
