Know all men by these presents that I John Morgan of the County of Orange and State of North Carolina for and in consideration of that love and good will which I have do here toward Jacob Flowers of the County aforesaid do give and grant & by these presents have given granted and made over unto Jacob Flowers his heirs & assigns forever named John Dinah Rachel and Isaac two horses called Dial and fancy four cows & calves four cows & lambs to have and to hold the said Negroes & above named stock from hence forth as his & their proper use without any manner of condition dues or Demands unto the Flowers his heirs and assigns forever and that I the Morgan for myself my heirs and assigns do quitclaim any Demand unto the property above named as witness my hand & Seal this tenth day of March one thousand seven hundred & Eighty Eight signed sealed and delivered in presence of

I Call whom these may come John Morgan do send greeting Remember that I John Morgan of the County of Orange State of North Carolina for and consideration of the love and good will which I have toward Jacob Flowers of said County have given granted and by these presents do give grant unto the said Jacob Flowers his heirs and assigns forever three certain tracts or parcels of Land situate lying and being in our County of Orange & Chatham on Cub Creek waters of such hope the first tract Beginning at 2 White Oak Saplings running N 30 Chains to a Pine then N 50 Chains to a White Oak then West to corner Pine & a long line crossing said Creek 45 Chains to a white Oak then South 30 Chains to a Pine then E 75 Chains to a white Oak thence North crossing the Creek 30 Chains to the beginning containing four hundred and fifty Acres the second tract is situate lying and being in Orange County on the waters of Morgan Creek adjoining his own Lands beginning at a pine run west 60 Chains to an Oak thence North 107 Chains to State then East 60 Chains to pine then South 107 Chains to the first station containing Six hundred and forty Acres the third tract is situate lying and being in Chatham on the Waters of Cub Creek & Bush Creek beginning at his own corner white Oak running South 220 Poles to a red Oak thence West 220 Poles to a pine

thence North 280 poles to a stake in his line thence
 East 228 poles to the beginning containing four
 hundred Acres Excepting one hundred Acres part
 parcel thereof sold by the said John Morgan
 to John Jones being the middle part of said tract of
 Land two of the of the said tracts of Land being
 Granted to John Morgan by Deeds Granted
 from Richard Caswell and the other from
 Alexander Martin Governors & commanders in
 chief of said State of North Carolina & the other
 by a Deed formerly Granted to Mark Morgan
 by Earl Granville as the records of same may
 fully appear recourse being had to the Registers
 office of the County of Orange and Chatham the
 tracts in the whole containing thirteen hundred and
 Ninety Acres to have and to hold the said tracts of
 parcels of Land and premises to him the said
 Jacob Flowers his heirs and assigns forever from
 hence forth as his and their property —
 absolutely without any manner of condition Distrain
 or any other dues to him the said Jacob Flowers his
 heirs and assigns forever will warrant and Defend

 of the County of Orange and State of North Carolina
 for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred
 pounds to me in hand paid by Peter Stout of the
 County and State aforesaid the receipt of which
 I do hereby acknowledge and myself therewith
 fully satisfied and do truly and absolute discharge
 the said Peter Stout have bargained and sold and by
 these presents do truly & fully Grant bargain sell
 release convey confirm and set over unto
 him the said Peter Stout his heirs and assigns
 forever a certain parcel of Land lying and being
 in Orange County aforesaid beginning at a white
 Oak running thence South forty Chains to a
 Oak thence west thirty three chains to a black Oak
 thence North Sixty chains to a Stake thence East
 thirty three chains to the first station containing
 by estimation two hundred Acres of Land it being
 a tract of Land entered in the Land office by
 Robert Baldrige Joel Romney & Thomas
 Mulholland the whole property conveyed in
 power of Thomas Mulholland and conveyed by
 from Thomas Mulholland to William Adams by Deed
 bearing Date the twenty first day of June in the year
 1785 and now conveyed by the said William Adams
 to the said Peter Stout to have and to hold the said
 two hundred Acres of Land bargained and sold and
 all and singular the rights and privileges
