

I, Mark Morgan of the same County, have given and granted and do by these presents fully give and unto my two sons Mark Morgan and John Morgan the following Land and premises to be divided between them in the following manner and form that always beginning from the head of Bully Morgans Creek and thence down the creek to the mouth of a Branch called the big Branch on the side of the creek thence the various courses of the Branch from the Mouth up to Barbours line. In the Lands on both sides of the said Creek from the aforesaid Run by Chertons and from the aforesaid Branch down to the County Line containing more or less, the said Land to be divided between them in the following manner viz. My son Mark to have the upper half of the said Land with the plantation whereon I now live, and my son John the lower half of the said Land also I give to my son Mark one hundred acres of Land adjoining Hardy Morgans Land and Edmund Toness Land also I give to my son John one hundred acres of Land adjoining

KNOW YE that whereas in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty four the 16th day of June and in the Infancy of Leamy Jones that a certain Deed of Orange County and State of North Carolina was by Deed of Gift conveyed unto the said Leamy Jones a certain Tract or parcel of Land in said County on the side of Bolings Creek being the upper part of a Tract of Land conveyed to the said Deed by Deed from John Morgan and containing by estimation one hundred and thirty acres — Be it known by these presents that John Morgan and Leamy above mentioned now my said Wife do for ourselves our heirs Executors Administrators and assigns for ever quit claim Release
