and my worldly Estate I give and bequeath as
followeth, I give to my Children Grief Evans
Vaughan and Sabarich Sutton one shilling
piece, I give to my children John Vaughan
Sarah, & Peggy, Peter & Pally born of my
wife Mary Vaughan my Land where I now
live to be equally divided between them and their
heirs forever, and my moveable Estate I give
my wife and Children aforesaid to be equally
divided between them and their heirs forever
I constitute and make my loving wife Mary and
James Walker my whole & sole Executors of this
last will and Testament In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & Seal this twenty third
day of October in the year of our Lord 1788

In the name of God Amen Samuel
Perkes Jun. being weak in body but in perfect
mind and memory and calling to mind that I am
appointed for all men once to die have made
Ordinances and declared this to be my last will and
Testament, and first I recommend my soul to
the hand of Almighty God that gave it and my body
to be decently buried by the care of my Executors
and as for such worldly goods as it hath pleased God
to bestow on me with give and bequeath in the following
manner and first I do give and bequeath to my
loving wife Mary my plantation on which I
now live containing two hundred & fifty Acres
and two hundred Acres of wood land lasting throughout
her life or a while she remains a widow
and after her death or marriage the lands to be sold and
equally divided among my Children and likewise I leave
her my Mill and a bay Mare and one Cow and a Pot
and her bed & bed cover, and I do give and bequeath to
my son Thomas one hundred Acres of Land where
he now lives joining Boldwins line and I do give
and bequeath to my son Samuel one hundred Acres
of Land where he lives, and I do give and bequeath to
my son Alexander one hundred Acres of Land I leave
my son Thomas, and I my son John one hundred
Acres of Land joining my son Samuels, that is to
say joining the hundred Acres of Land I left my
son Samuel, and further I order that my
Executors sell one hundred Acres of Land my
property lying joining James Percken

on Stony Creek and I do further Order that a year
Credit be allowed the purchaser of said Land
and that payment be made to Sonny of Stony Creek
for the money they have expended in taking up
land, and further I order that my executor take
ten pounds of the money raised from the sale
of said lands and apply it to schooling my
Daughter FINE son named William, and my
Daughter Nancy's son named Alexander
and the remaining part of the price of said
hundred acres, I leave and give to my Son
James, and I do give and leave to my daughter
Nancy a Young Black Mare two years old &
a Cow & I give and leave my Daughter FINE
one two year old Heifer, and further I give
my Son John my Rifle Gun, and as for the
remainder of my moveable property, I leave
to my Wife during her life or widowhood and
to pay my Debts and at her Death to be equally
divided amongst all my Children, and I leave
John Robinson & my wife Mary and William
Raney my Executors and heirs to have set
my Hand & Seal.

KNOW all men by these Presents that I
Thomas King of the County and in the State
of North Carolina am held and firmly bound
unto and obliged to Jeremiah Edge of the County
and State aforesaid in the sum of one thousand
pounds currency to be paid to the said Jeremiah
Edge or to his certain attorney his heirs Executors
Adm^{rs} or assigns, for the true payment whereof
I bind myself my heirs Executors and Administra-
tors firmly by these presents In witness whereof
I have set my hand and Seal this 16th day of
October in the year of our Lord 1788.

The Condition of this obligation is such
that if the above bounden Thomas King shall
well and truly perform the agreement made
between the said Thomas King & Jeremiah
Edge which is as follows,
That whereas the said Thomas King has proposed
to leave his wife and Children and travel, hath
agreed with Jeremiah Edge to take to himself
of his personal estate a feather bed and a
Sow & Pigg, and a Cow and Calf and two
Hens & six plates and a Dish & a Bason and
a small Pott & six Bottles and a Cane and half
the Hogs and half the Corn and a plow and
half the Tobacco that will be left after his Debts
is paid and all the rest of his personal estate
and the Land that he the said Thomas King
bought of Col. Duke and the Land that the said
Thomas King took up in partnership with Jeremiah Edge
