County of Orange and State of North Carolina being through the
humblet obediency and goodness of God the weak in body yet of
sound and perfect understanding and memory doth constitute
and ordain my last will and Testament and desire it may be
observed by all as such

I will that all my debts be paid by my Executors &
Custodiers hereafter named

Item I do give and bequeath unto my living wife Margaret
with whom I have had a number of years peaceable and
quiet one Horse to the value of twenty pounds one feather
bed and furniture, and a Negroe Woman named Sate, and
for her death or Marriage to be equally divided between
my two Sons David & Isaac. Item I do give and bequeath
to my daughter Jean the sum of five shillings to be paid
by my Executors and Custodier. Item I do give to my

son William One hundred Acres of Land part of the tract
now lies on to be laid off so that the said land shall
have a width on the South East line as on the North
line, including the improvement the said William now

now lies on Item I do give to my son James
the Plantation he now lies on containing three hundred
Acres, for which see is to pay the sum of ten pounds
to be paid to my son David after the Execution of the
my last will or a Deed to him.

Item I do give to my son John all my wearing apparel
except one great coat, Item I do give to my daughter
Margaret Abbott one Scarlet Cardinal or the value
thereof in money. Item I do give and bequeath
to my Daughter Mary Patterson the sum of five shillings
to be paid by my Custodiers. Item I do give to my

Daughter Agnes one horse to the value of twenty
pounds, one feather Bed and furniture two
and Calves, and one year old, one Spinning wheel
also five pounds in money. Item I do give and
bequeath all the remaining part of my Estate, to my
two Sons David and Isaac, I do constitute my wife
Margaret and my Son David Executors of this my last
Will and Testament and trustees for my Son Isaac
