him and his heirs for ever I likewise leave and bequeath
to my Grand son James Gray Twenty pounds to
him and his heirs for ever I leave and bequeath
to my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Gray one
feather bed bolster and pillows with two flannel

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beds one pair of Blankets one Coverlid
with an addition of a Counterpin stamped
I likewise leave and bequeath to my Grand
son James Paul Twenty pounds to him
and his heirs for ever I likewise and bequeath
my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Paul one
the Bed and furniture to her and her heirs
for ever I likewise leave and bequeath to my
Daughters Margaret and Elizabeth all my
estate equally to be divided between them, to
them and their heirs for ever I likewise leave
and bequeath to my Daughter Margaret all
the remainder of my Estate remaining after
the above

In the name of God Amen I Daniel Sullivan
 of the County of Orange and State of North Carolina
 being very sick and weak in body but of perfect
 Mind and memory thanks be given unto God
 Calling to mind the mortality of my Body
 knowing that it is appointed for all Men once
 to die, do make and ordain this my last Will
 and Testament that is say principally as follows
 First of all I give and recommend my soul
 into the hand of almighty God that give
 and my body I Recommend to the Earth to be
 buried in decent Christian Burial and at the
 discretion of my Executors, nothing doubting

at the general Resurrection I shall receive
 the same again by the mighty power of God
 And as touching such worldly Estate which
 it has pleased God to bless me in this
 life. I give devise and dispose of the same
 in the following manner and form. First.
 I give and bequeath to Margaret my dearly
 loved wife one hundred acres of Land
 the West side of the Tract during her
 lifetime and after her death to be my
 son Sullivan I also give to him one young
 black Horse one Cow and Calf one Ewe and
 Lamb one sow and pigs Also I give to my old
 son Joseph Sullivan one hundred acres
 Land on the South side of the Tract
 I also give him one young Sord Mare and
 Cow and Calf one Ewe and Lamb one
 sow and pigs. Also I give my son Daniel
 Sullivan one hundred acres Land joining
 the first I also give him one horse one Cow &
 Calf one Ewe and Lamb one Sow & pigs
 Also I give my youngest son Edmund Sullivan
 one hundred acres of Land joining the
