Continental service and now knowing how soon
I may be called to the war. Being in perfect
mind & Memory thanks be to god for it calling unto
mind the Mortality of my body & knowing that I
am appointed for all men once to die do make & ordain
this my Last will & Testament that is to say first
and first of all I give & recommend my soul into the
hands & care of the Almighty god that gave it & my
body After Death. I recommend to the earth to be
buried nothing doubting but at the general

Resurrection I shall receive, I shall receive the same
again by the mighty power of God And Touching
such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased god to
bless me with I give demise and Dispose of the same
in the following Manner & form first I give & bequeath
to Catharine my Dearly beloved Wife a Negro woman
name Jann two Mare fine head of Cattle & a number
of Hogs with the Increase of the same Except the first
that the young mare brings which is Henry
Browns property & Furthermore the said Catharine
is to have all and every thing that she had before
married to her with every thing that is left at my
Death with all debts and Moveable Effects, except
five shillings Sterling which I also give to my
Daughter Mary Randall, I do therefore confirm
this and no other to be my last will & Testament in
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal
this eighteenth day of July in the year of our Lord
1777 Signed sealed published
