 Lameness in one of her fore legs, and one single high
 top chaise or carriage with harness complete

 mentioned property unto the said John Umstead his
 heirs or Executors his or their only proper use and behoof
 forever, and I the said Norman Bigelow for myself
 my heirs Executors, Administrators and assigns from &
 against all persons shall and will warrant & defend
 the Sale of the above mentioned property In witness

 day of February one thousand seven hundred & ninety
